To the Recommender:

The Center for Conservation Leadership (CCL) develops and empowers the next generation of conservation leaders to understand the importance of human interaction with the environment and to take responsibility for its care and preservation. CCL seeks motivated high school students (current freshman - juniors) from diverse backgrounds with a keen interest in the environment and a passion for the outdoors. The year-long program combines environmental education, leadership training and community service in a field based in-depth program.

CCL begins in June, 2021 with ***The Path to Conservation***, a series of videos, virtual meetings and field trips that introduce the students to the icons of the conservation movement. This is followed by an introduction to the various eco-systems and habitats in our northern Illinois region. We also engage the students in a guided exploration of the green spaces nearest their homes to broaden their environmental awareness.

Following that, students undertake an ***Action Project***, tackling an issue that has meaning to them as a group. Together they find solutions and work to plan stewardship work that has meaning in their community. We also participate in several field trips and workdays, improving the local areas in which we live. The program culminates with a ***three week trip*** to northern Wisconsin in June 2022 designed to be an integrated and interactive experience. The group hikes, backpacks, canoes, kayaks and rock climbs, incorporating all they have learned.

Throughout the program, students continue to have more opportunities to challenge themselves, build relationships, and explore the environment. CCL is challenging and rewarding as it develops young conservation leaders for the future.
